How to Set Up Your Fundraising Page

Visit our [Fundraising for World Central Kitchen](#) page to create your fundraising campaign.

Select **As an Individual** if you're fundraising:

- On your own
- As a singular organization or entity

Select **Create a Team** if you're fundraising:

- As a collaborative (multiple people/ organizations fundraising towards a common goal)
- Across teams/departments within an organization
- You welcome others that visit your page to join you in fundraising towards your goal

Once you select the correct fundraiser type, create your campaign by setting your fundraising goal and campaign end date. Click "I'm fundraising in honor of someone else" if you would like to fundraise in honor or in memory of an individual or you would like to remove the fundraising goal from your page. You'll be able to customize your page with pictures, videos, and stories to get your community excited about supporting WCK.

GENERAL WCK TALKING POINTS

- World Central Kitchen is a nonprofit organization that provides fresh meals in response to humanitarian, climate, and community crises.
- We believe food is a universal human right.
- We respond with the urgency of now because when people are hungry, it cannot wait. We must act now.
- We know that a nourishing meal in a time of crisis is so much more than a plate of food—it’s hope, it’s dignity, and it’s a sign that someone cares about you and that you are not alone.

Fundraising Tips and Tricks

1

Start Small & Start Close

Think about starting your fundraiser with the people closest to you. Friends and family are great resources that can add visibility and support to get your fundraiser off the ground.

2

Share Your "Why"

Fundraising is an opportunity to share your values and vision of the world you'd like to help create. Be sure to add your personal connections to WCK's work.

3

Check for Employer Matches

If you're planning to fundraise in your office, check to see if your employer is willing to create (or has already created) a matching program for charitable organizations.

4

Contextualize the Donation

All donations help provide meals for families in need. Even a \$3, \$5, or \$10 gift makes a difference - any amount can help WCK provide a meal for someone in the days and weeks following a disaster.

Frequently Asked Questions

What does the money I raise go towards?

All of our fundraisers support our mission of being first to the frontlines, providing meals in response to humanitarian, climate, and community crises. Read more about our current relief efforts [here](#).

Can I collect cash and check donations towards my fundraiser?

Absolutely. Once you have a final tally of your physical donations, please send an email to fundraise@wck.org, detailing:

- Each individual donor's name
- The donation amount
- The check number
- If they'd like to make their donation anonymously

After providing those details, the donations can be added to your online total.

How can I thank my donors?

There are two ways to thank your incredible donors:

- 1 By interacting with them in the comments section of your page's activity feed.
- 2 By clicking on Manage, and navigating to the Donors tab. From here you can send emails to all donors that provided an email address.

Will my donors get a receipt?

A donation receipt is automatically sent upon completion of a donation, but please reach out to fundraise@wck.org, and we'll be happy to resend a receipt to any of the people that donated to your fundraiser.

Can my organization talk about our fundraiser for WCK?

Yes, absolutely. We do ask that if you are posting something publicly, you send it to us for a quick courtesy review. We just want to make sure that our work is being accurately presented as our efforts can change very quickly.

We also ask that you refrain from using the word "partner." WCK uses the term partner to describe those that we work with on the ground, so we prefer that with any mention of WCK, you include the terms "supporting," "benefiting," "fundraising for," or something similar.

Can we include WCK in a press release? Or would WCK include us in a press release about our fundraiser?

WCK does not issue press releases. However, we welcome you to share your support in a press release of your own. We ask that you not include WCK boilerplate language, but we are happy to review any mentions of WCK.

Can WCK promote my fundraiser?

WCK's social media feeds and other communication channels are focused on WCK's work on the field; therefore, WCK cannot promote individual fundraisers.
